Eco-friendly tourism

Our company, with the goal of improving the efficiency of its environmental and energy management systems, has planned a series of structural interventions. Help us with our project by adopting small but essential actions to ensure the success of our journey toward environmental preservation:

- We change towels daily; please place on the floor only those you wish to have replaced;
- Single-use soap sets have been replaced with dispensers to reduce waste volume, limit environmental impact, and minimize product dispersion;
- Remember to turn off unnecessary lights: efficient use of available lighting helps significantly reduce electricity consumption. Remove the magnetic key card when leaving the room;
- Turn off the tap while brushing your teeth or showering when water is not needed;
- Our hotels support a waste sorting campaign; please help us by using the designated colored bags for waste types (blue for plastic and white for paper);
- Always close the windows if the heating and/or air conditioning system is running;
- Remember to turn off all electrical devices before going to sleep;
- Adjust the internal temperature based on your needs using the provided controls. Note that temperatures for optimal physiological comfort should be around 20°C in winter and 6°–7°C lower than the outdoor temperature (but not exceeding 26°C) in summer;
- Return the electronic key card to the Reception so it can be reused;
- Report any inefficiencies (leaks, malfunctions, etc.);
- Suggest other useful measures to protect the environment and contribute to our campaign.

Caring for the environment can continue outside our hotels:

- Choose local food and drinks to reduce emissions from transportation, as transporting goods causes significant pollution in terms of emissions and resource use;
- Use a reusable water bottle to avoid plastic bottles; Rome is rich in fountains providing fresh and potable water;
- Continue waste sorting outside the hotel by using the appropriate bins for each type of waste;
- Check the availability of public transport for local travel when planning visits to specific areas of the city;
- Explore the city using the most eco-friendly means available; for example, you can visit the historic center by renting a bicycle from dedicated rental points;
- Share your sustainable experience with us and other guests on our social media channels
